Beginning Friday Evening, 25 January, the Moreno Psychodrama Society and the Psychodrama Institute of Melbourne are bringing the Theatre of Spontaneity to 155 Langridge Street in Collingwood.

From 7.30 – 10.30 pm on the last Friday of every month (apart from holidays-see dates opposite) there will be psychodramatic events, the living newspaper, the magic shop, sculptured moments from the day that have been special or intriguing, sociodrama on everyday situations. Sometimes there will be a set theme brought forward by the producer/s and at other times, whatever emerges from the group will be followed using sociometry, sociodrama, or role training methods. The conductors of this 'Theatre of Spontaneity' are psychodramatists. The Theatre of Spontaneity was one of the earliest forms of psychodrama to be practised in the United States of America by Dr. J. L. Moreno, originator of the psychodrama method; there is a book of the same name by him.
